	All players need to arrive at the venue 30 minutes prior to commencement of trials to register and warm-up i.e. girls at 7.30am, and boys at 2.30pm.
•	Both girls and boys should bring a plain white playing shirt and a dark blue or black coloured playing shirt and a pair of white socks
•	Both selection trials will involve skills and fitness testing (including a five lap run – girls in under 7 minutes and boys in under 6)
	A nomination form is attached and needs to be returned to the Academy Office by <b>Friday 16 August 2013</b> (for both boys and girls)
	All hockey players who forward nomination forms should automatically attend the appropriate selection trial
•	Following the trials players will be informed of the selection outcomes via mail
